## <u>Tournament Site Rules:</u> There will be no coaches meeting, but please find the site director to check in.

- 1. There will be a full concession and T-shirt sales available all day at both schools. No outside coolers, crockpots, etc. allowed on site unless players or parents have special dietary needs. Concessions are a main fundraiser for our club, we appreciate your support!
- 2. We will charge \$8.00 for all spectators. Children under 5 and Senior Citizens (60 or older) are free
- 3. Cash or checks will be accepted no credit cards.
- 4. Please enter at door N1 at Superior High School and use the activities door right off of Hammond Ave at Superior Middle School. All other doors will be locked.
- 5. All Tournament schedules and scores will be on AES (www.advancedeventsystems.com)
- 6. Good sportsmanship is required of all. Yelling at the officiating crew, talking poorly about other individuals, teams, or clubs, etc. will not be tolerated.
- 7. Be on time. Coaches need to make sure that warm-ups, time-outs, and team meetings are on time.
- 8. Teams must bring their own first aid supplies. We will have ice packs available in the concession area if needed. (There are no medical trainers onsite).
- 9. Teams can set up camps in the hallway outside the gym ONLY. **Please clean up your area before you leave! Thank you!** Please be respectful of our facility and do not wander the halls.
- 10. No playing with balls (dribbling, passing, throwing, etc.) outside of the gym. *These areas have breakable equipment, lights, and sprinkler heads.*
- 11. Any facility/site safety issues/concerns, please discuss with the site director or assistant.
- 12. The facility will open 30 minutes prior to the start of the first match.
- 13. The first match will start at 8:00am. Teams will start timed warmups.
- 14. Medals will be awarded for 1st place finishers in each division (Gold, Silver, Bronze).

## **Match Rules/Playoff Format:**

- 1. USAV rules apply. (Net height, substitutions, net/centerline faults, starting lineup checks).
- 2. 3 and 4 team Pools: Best of 3 sets. First two to 25, must win by two or cap at 27. Third game if needed, first to 15, must win by two or cap at 17.
- 3. Team Bench Area Teams will occupy the same bench area throughout the entire match. Only team personnel may be seated at the bench. We won't switch courts.
- 4. Timeouts will be 30 seconds. Each team will be allowed 2 timeouts per set.

- 5. Serve or receive will be determined by captains choosing numbers from 1-5. Closest wins their choice. (no coin toss). Home and Visitor designation for scorekeepers will also be determined.
- 6. Please bring your own warm up balls. Game balls will be provided for all courts.
- 7. Warm-ups will be 2-4-4 for 10-min warm-up (first matches only) and 1-2-2 for the 5-min warm-up (remaining matches). When not warming up, please help teams shag balls out of respect for other courts and matches that may be playing.
